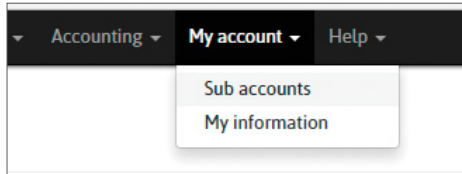


RELATED ACCOUNTS

One account will be designated as the main account. The accounts that are associated with the main account will be a sub account. You can have many sub accounts, but only one main account. The main account can view the sub account(s) available to manage by selecting Sub Accounts from the My account section.



STEP 1: Change between accounts

Swapping between accounts is easy, just select one of the accounts located in the My Account menu.

An alert menu will appear at the top of the page when you are managing one of the sub accounts.

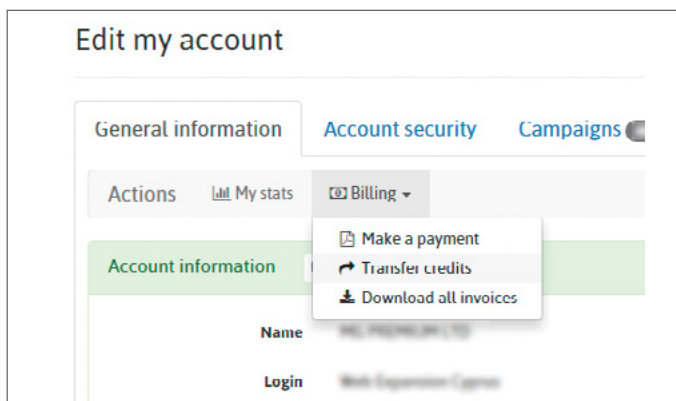

STEP 2: Credit Transfer Feature

All accounts associated with the parent account must have the same company information in order to transfer funds. Once the company information matches, the main account can transfer funds from any sub-account with a positive balance. After you click on the account you want to transfer the credits from, select the option Transfer Credits.



Then just follow the 2 step wizard where you can add Receiver and amount. In the 2nd step you can confirm or go back.

STEP 3: Create an Insertion Order

The parent account has the ability to upload funds directly to each sub-account by creating an IO directly in the sub-account. Navigate to my accounts and select the sub-accounts nav. Click on create IO next to the sub-account you wish to create an IO for.
